








# Single Stream Recycling

## What is Single Stream Recycling?

The process of collecting fibers (cardboard, office paper, newspaper, etc.) and rigids (soda cans, tins/steels, glass, plastics and cartons) together. This process of collection was created to make recycling easier and, in hopes, increase recycling rates.
