Interim Chairman Roy Lemke called the January monthly meeting to order at 7:00PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present. Clerk Karen Schuldt took the roll call.

6. Visitors/Speakers to Address the Board:

- Greg Meinertz and John McCoy from Crescent Hills drive addressed the board with their concern of a hunter utilizing the easement with a loaded shotgun. They talked to Houston County Sheriffs office and the La Crescent Police Department along with the local DNR officer about this concern of safety. There appears to be a grey area of concern on who has jurisdiction of the easement area. After further discussion Jason is going to follow up with the local law enforcement and the township attorney.

8. Clerk Report:

10. Supervisors Report:

- Roy gave an update that Jason & Doug put a new cutting edge on the plow truck. Also, the pump went out on the auger on the sander. Roy also mentioned there was a tree down on Potter Rd that was cleared and there may need to be some brushed cleaned up in the spring.
